Currently, I serve as the President of the HS association in the NE and am part of a 10-district board that governs HS soccer in the state of Ohio. The OSSCA board is structured close to our new OSA board. If elected, I am excited to bring both organizations closer in a partnership to grow and enrich soccer in Ohio. Together we can strengthen the bridge between youth and HS and build Ohio soccer as a model for the nation to follow. Currently OSSCA is the largest membership body in the USC association.

With the youth and HS partnering along with our adult, collegiate and MLS groups we can become the strongest soccer unit in the US. This is what I want to work on and not dream of but to bring to fruition. As an OYSAN board member I have seen many changes in the game and the governance from the national soccer body. The new merger may be the most exciting evolution of all my experiences.
