1. In conjunction with the Head Coach for ODP, assist in the selection, training, evaluation of ODP State and District Staff
 - a. Development of and implementation of a realistic curriculum for ODP Staff
 - b. Utilize best efforts in promotion of ODP with club, coaches, parents, and players
 - c. Co-ordinate with District Head Coaches in all phases of ODP
2. Organization of and attendance at all ODP training sessions (Phase I – Phase IV). Activities will include:
 - a. Assist in the recruiting and placement of ODP District Staff (Phase I and Phase II)
 - b. Coordinate the District Staff scheduling for all age groups.
 - c. Attend planning and organizational meetings as designated by ODP Head Coach
 - d. Hold pre-event training and organizational meetings with ODP District Staff Coaches
 - e. Assist ODP Head Coach in finding coaching substitutes in the event of absence
 - f. Serve as the OSA point-of-contact for all District Training Sessions
 - g. Ensure on site organization on the day of events, including facilities, fields marked, fields identified, and staff assigned to age groups,
 - h. Assist with any additional organizational requirements deemed necessary by the ODP Head Coach or OSA Staff Members
 - i. Be responsible for the administration and collection of ODP Player rankings and evaluations
 - j. Required position as a State Team Head Coach (Phase III/Phase IV). Note this position will be compensated outside at standard State Staff rates and is not included in this stipend.
 - k. Laisse with the on-site ODP Administrators regarding all logistical matters regarding District Training (Phase I) and the District Festival (Phase II).
 - l. Model the professional expectations of OSA with reference to behavior, dress code, and professional conduct at all times.
 - m. Assist with any additional organizational requirements deemed necessary by the ODP Head Coach for hosting a successful Phase III State Pool Event.
