



## GAME DAY PROCEDURE

This document outlines the game day procedure for the OSA Nike Development League Columbus and Cleveland. Be sure to read through this document so you are familiar with the game day procedure.

### GAME REQUIREMENTS

Upon arriving at the field, please make sure that you have the below documents. We will NOT be using game day rosters for the Fall 2021 Season.

- **EITHER** Laminated Player Passes or PDF Player Passes
- **EITHER** Laminated Coach Pass or PDF Coach Pass

Only players who are US Youth Soccer registered and hold a valid Ohio Soccer Association player pass (or PDF) are eligible to participate in the league games. Coaches must make sure that they are in compliance with the OSA Safe Soccer (Risk) to be on the sideline.

All teams are to pay the referees prior to the start of the scheduled game. Review the “Referee Fee’s” document for age group breakdowns.

### SCORE SUBMISSION

Upon completion of the game, the WINNING TEAM or home team in the event of a tie, will enter the score via the online link below.

### REFEREE NO SHOW

If you are at your scheduled game and your referee has not appeared and its within 10 minutes of kick-off, please call/text the OSDL Ohio Soccer Cell Phone at 440-584-0090.

### CANCELLED GAMES DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER

If a game is cancelled due to inclement weather, the following procedures must be met immediately.

1. Notify the opposing team(s) of the cancellation and if you know your referee assignor notify them as well
2. Call or text Ohio Soccer cell phone at 440-584-0090 to notify us of the cancelled game
3. Email [jeberle@ohio-soccer.org](mailto:jeberle@ohio-soccer.org) with the game number and originally scheduled date and note that the game will be rescheduled due to inclement weather.
4. Begin rescheduling with opposing team(s).

All reschedules **must** be completed with 72 hours (3 days) of the cancelled game.
