



SPRING 2022 SCHEDULING INFORMATION

This document outlines the scheduling information needed for the OSA Nike Developmental League – Columbus & Cleveland (OSDL) fall season. Be sure to read through this document so that you are familiar with all requirements of the scheduling process.

Scheduling for all division teams and all age groups will be done by the respective teams within your assigned division on Saturday, January 29th, 2022 at Nationwide Hotel and Conference Center. The OSDL – Columbus & Cleveland mandatory scheduling meetings based on the availability and hosting information provided by the teams. If a team does not provide availability information, then the team will be presumed to be available for all play dates throughout the season.

Spring season play may begin on Friday, March 4th, 2022. All games must be scheduled to be played on or before Sunday, June 5th, 2022.

INTRODUCTION

The mandatory scheduling meeting is for all 2022 spring boys and girls OSDL – Columbus & Cleveland teams. Teams will have the opportunity to develop and finalize their schedules, face-to-face, with other teams in their division. If you do not have a representative at this meeting, then it will be assumed that your team is available for all play dates throughout the season. The expectation is to have completed game schedules after each meeting.

A coach, team manager or designee is expected to attend these scheduling meetings for each and/or multiple participating teams. If team(s) fail to actively participate in the scheduling process the League Administrator has the authority to accept a schedule without approval by all teams.

GENERAL SCHEDULING INFORMATION

Division schedules will be overseen by the League Administrator, who will have sole discretion in the manner by which game schedules are developed. Teams who enter OSDL - Columbus & Cleveland must be committed and available to play during the published dates of the season.

LOCATION OF GAMES

There are two (3) categories for scheduling/hosting OSDL – Columbus games:

- **Single Game:** A team hosts a game between itself and another team within its division.
- **Group Hosting:** A team hosts a number of games over a weekend amongst teams from within its division.
- **Group Play Weekend:** The league hosts a number of games over a weekend amongst teams from within its division, cross-league or other current OSA carded teams

GROUND RULES & PROCEDURES

Spring season play may begin on Friday, March 4th, 2022. All games must be scheduled to be played on or before Sunday, June 5th, 2022.

Ground Rules

- The goal is to complete your OSDL – Columbus & Cleveland schedule for the 2022 spring season.
- **Travel:** All teams understand that teams may have to travel throughout the Columbus/Cleveland and the surrounding cities. The determination of game location is based, in part, due to home locations of teams within a division and field availability.
- **Coaches:** Teams should understand that due to the nature of scheduling games for the benefit of a single coach who coaches multiple teams should not be expected.
- OSDL – Columbus & Cleveland does not prohibit teams from scheduling more than one (1) game per day if the teams mutually agree.
- If scheduling two (2) games in one (1) day, OSDL - Columbus & Cleveland stipulates that efforts are to be made so that a minimum of three (3) hours rest occur between games (from the end of the first game to the start of the second).
- In the event that there is a conflict where teams are unable to mutually agree upon a date, time and location for their game, the League Administrator will be involved to resolve the conflict.

Procedures

- Prior to arriving to the scheduling meeting, all teams should have their available dates/times as well as field available listed and with them. This is to assist with the scheduling process and ensure that teams are able to determine date/time/location effectively.
- Teams should reconfirm that a home team has the number of fields available necessary in order to play one (1) or multiple games at the same time and provide for equal rest time if applicable. Teams should also reconfirm the playing surface of each field.
- Utilizing the scheduling matrix provided to each team, list date, time and location agreed to by teams next to game pairings.
- Once the schedule is submitted to the League Administrator at the end of the division meeting, the schedule will be entered into the league scheduling system within 48 hours of the scheduling meeting.
